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Eligibility Criteria



Existing worker

Existing worker is defined for the purposes of the Strategic Skills Program (SSP) as a person 20 years of age or older who has been in paid employment for at least one hour in the week prior to commencement of training; or a person 15-19 years of age who is not formally enrolled in school and has been in paid employment for more than 15 hours in the week prior to commencement of training.

Job seeker

A job seeker means someone who is broadly not currently working and seeking or intending to seek paid employment.

Participants

- Must not be enrolled in secondary or tertiary education.
- Must be an Australian Citizen or a foreign national with Australia permanent residency or a New Zealand passport holder who has been resident in Australia for a least six months or a Humanitarian refugee.
- Must be a NSW resident or a person who works in NSW.

Fee exemption or concession
